

Message from Asia-Pacific Network for Global Change Research (APN)



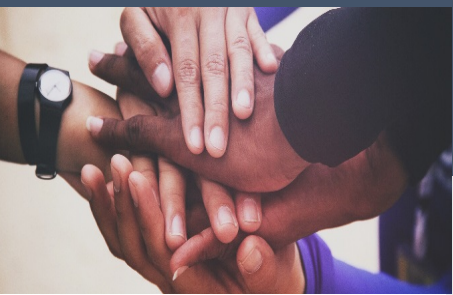
Strengthening Collaboration In Asia and the Pacific

With the above, APN also takes this opportunity to invite like-minded individuals and organizations to **submit proposals to benefit the goals and objectives of AOGEO.**

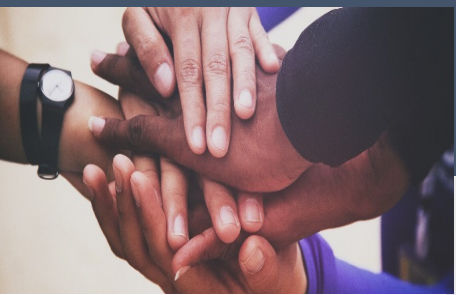
